Faroe Islands on Patrol 2025

From the **26th until the 29th of may 2025** the *International Police Association Section Denmark* would like to welcome active-duty IPA members from different sections for the event:

Faroe Islands On Patrol 2025.

This event is meant to strengthen the bond between the international participants via joined activities and exchange of information. It is a possibility to attract young members to be more active within their section and to attract new members by showing the possibilities a membership of our unique association can provide.

There is a promotional, professional, social and cultural aspect in the planned schedule.

Planned Schedule (subject to change):

DAY 1: (Civilian clothing)

Until afternoon with flight arrivals.

0400 pm: Greeting and introduction of the hosts, participants and schedule.

0500 pm: Senior management inform about the structure and tasks of the Faroese Police.

0600 pm: A guided walk through Tórshavn city center, with the opportunity to try local beverages.

1930 pm: Dinner at the police station.

???? pm: Transport to the housing facilities (Residence of local IPA members).

DAY 2: (Civilian clothing)

0800 am: Breakfast at the police station.

0900 am: Mountain hike to the police shooting range.

1200 am: Lunch at the shooting range.

0100 pm: A demonstration of the different weapon platforms available to the local police, and the opportunity to shoot at the range.

0400 pm: Presentation of lifeboats in Tórshavn and sailing trip with the boat. During the sailing trip, you are lifted into a rescue helicopter.

1900 pm: Dinner at the police station.

???? pm: Transport to the housing facilities.

DAY 3: (Civilian/uniform clothing)

0800 am: Breakfast at the police station.

0900 am: Tour of the station. Presentation of the call- and emergency center.
Presentation of patrol cars, dog patrol and the traffic patrol.

1030 am: Bus tour / sightseeing of the Islands.
(an forward) - See the old radar station and bunker, which is becoming active again and enjoying the viewpoint on the mountain.
- Visiting the village of Tjørnuvík with old/classic Faroese houses that people still live in.
- Lunch in the village.
- Continuation of the bus trip, traveling to the second largest island Eysturoy, where participants can enjoy afternoon tea.
- Hereafter return to the capital through a subsea tunnel with the world's first subsea roundabout, located on the bottom of the sea.

1800 pm: Tour of the local OY brewery. Subsequent dining where local IPA members join. Entertainment is also included.

???? pm: Transport to the accommodation.

DAY 4: (Civilian Clothing)

0900 am: Breakfast at the police station.

???? am: Transport to the airport. Depending on travel time etc. sightseeing on the island of Vágur will be possible, depending on individual departing time.

Accommodation / housing facilities.

Local Danish IPA members offered housing at their personal residence for this event. There are good bathing facilities at the Police station, and these are available throughout the day. Transport between the police station and accommodation will be provided.

Getting here:

Fly: Vágur Airport (FAE) - Only public airport on the islands.

There are opportunities to fly from various bigger European cities to the Faroe Islands. If possible, we recommend traveling with the local airline, *Atlantic Airways*, due to superior technical equipment, and therefore fewer cancellations.

Sail: Tórshavn (Port of Tórshavn)

It is also possible to sail with the ferry *Norrøna* with the company *Smyril Line*. This trip takes approx. 32-35 hours. Arrives Monday morning from Hirtshals in Denmark. Sails back to Denmark on Thursday evening.

(Transfer to/from the airport or port of Tórshavn is provided by IPA Denmark)



Participation conditions

IPA members who speak the English language and who are in active duty, are welcome to sign up for **“Faroe Islands on Patrol 2025”** through their Countries National Executive Committee.

Maximum of participants:	12 (one nominee per IPA section)
Maximum age of participants:	40 years at event start.
Deadline for application:	16th of february 2025.

The following costs are included for participants and provided by IPA Denmark:

- Accommodation in private residences hosted by IPA members.
- Meals (Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner)
- Tours and entrances fees as described in program incl. dining at the OY brewery.
- Local transfer to and from the airport on the Faroe Islands.

The following costs are for the participant or invited IPA Section (not included):

- Travel (to and from Faroe Islands)
- All other costs which are not mentioned (Visa, Travel insurance etc.)

All participants need to be aware that all pictures and videos being taken during the official schedule, will be subject for use as promotional purposes of the International Police Association. All represented sections will get access to these pictures to use them only for IPA, not for commercial purposes.

If your section is interested in sending a participant to this event, please let us know as soon as possible to reserve a spot for your representative.
