# **Application Requirements**

This event is open to active police officers who are IPA members, regardless of whether they hold a black belt in judo. Women's judoka will provide instruction to female participants.

#### Costs

A: Double Occupancy (Participant and Spouse/Parter)

B: Single Occupancy ¥ 108,500 (JPY)

(One Hundred Eight Thousand and Five Hundred Yen)

Includes: Accommodation, transfer from Narita airport, two meals at Chiba police HQRS, dinners on 25th and 28th, round-trip transfers between hotel and Dojo, and all transfers of Fuji-Hakone National Park tour.
