IPA Romanian Section is pleased to invite you to the 2025 Young Police Officers' Seminar (YPOS) that will be in Bucharest, the capital of Romania, from November 10 (arrival) to November 15 (departure).

The accommodation is provided by **Hotel MyContinental Bucharest**, located about 16 km from the international airport.

Bucharest Henri Coandă International Airport is situated just outside the city. To reach the hotel, take the Henri Coandă Express train from the airport to Gara de Nord (Bucharest North Station). The journey takes around 20 minutes, and from there, the hotel is just a 2-minute walk away.

The participation fee is **250 Euro per participant**, and cover accommodation (1 person sharing a double room), training, excursions, and meals during the mentioned period. These fee does not include any travel costs.

Each participant will receive IPA promotional materials and some things that they will need during the seminar. The participants need a good physical and medical condition.

The topic of YPOS 2025 is Law enforcement institutions - integrated system it will be delivered in English and, therefore, the participants must have a good knowledge of English.

Also the participants should be active police officers and should have been in active service for a maximum of 10 years.

Attached, you will find the YPOS Registration form, and we encourage early registration to avoid disappointment. The registration will close on **August 29**, or earlier if demand is met. The forms of payment will be announced after registration.
