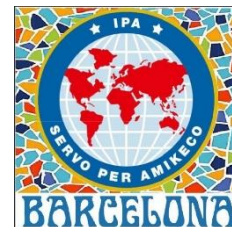

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INFORMATION DOSSIER – IPA FRATERNITY GAMES 2026

1. General Presentation

The IPA Fraternity Games 2026 represent much more than a sports event. They are an international project of coexistence, sport, and public service, promoted by the International Police Association (IPA), with the support of local institutions, sports organizations, and security and emergency services from around the world.

From May 22 to 25, 2026, Barcelona will host a unique event where police officers, firefighters, healthcare professionals, and members of emergency services will share values, experiences, and challenges in an environment of fraternity, respect, and collaboration.

Under the motto “**Sport, Health, Fraternity, and Service**”, the Games aim to:

- Recognize the daily work of those who protect and serve the community.
- Promote a positive, approachable, and human image of security and emergency services.
- Strengthen personal and institutional bonds through sport as a common language.

Main goals

1. **Recognition and appreciation of public service:** to honor the work of police officers, firefighters, healthcare professionals, and emergency teams.
2. **Promote fraternity and international cooperation:** to build trustful relationships among professionals from different countries.
3. **Encourage physical activity and healthy habits:** to promote sport as a source of health and cohesion.
4. **Enhance the image of Barcelona:** to position the city as a reference for international events integrating sport, culture, and social values.
5. **Create a positive social and institutional impact:** to generate synergies between institutions, organizations, and companies committed to society.

Values of the Games

- **Sport:** unity, self-improvement, and respect.
- **Health:** active lifestyle and well-being.
- **Fraternity:** human bonds that transcend uniforms, languages, and borders.
- **Service:** commitment to society and the value of public service.



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2. Context and Purpose

The IPA Fraternity Games are an initiative of **IPA Barcelona**, supported by IPA Catalunya and IPA España, with collaboration from public and private organizations committed to community service.

Project Evolution

The event has undergone strategic planning, the definition of sports disciplines, venues, logistics, and sports management, consolidating a strong and cross-functional master plan. Barcelona 2026 represents the culmination of rigorous work with both national and international projection.

Impact

- **Social:** promotes coexistence, inclusion, and citizen recognition for those who serve others.
- **Sporting:** encourages physical activity as a source of health, well-being, and cohesion.
- **Institutional:** strengthens the image of Barcelona and IPA as models of cooperation and excellence.

Recognition of Professionals

The event honors all frontline workers—security personnel, firefighters, and rescue teams—symbolizing courage, fraternity, and commitment to society.



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3. Activities Report 2025 / Preparation 2026

Actions Taken

- Formation of the Organizing Committee and functional structure.
- Preliminary presentations to institutions and security bodies.
- Design of visual identity and institutional narrative: "Sport, Health, Fraternity, and Service."
- Preparation of sponsorship dossier and initial contacts with organizations.
- Creation of official communication channels and website with forms and online payment.
- Coordination of sports venues and opening of registrations.

Participation and Collaborations

- **Public institutions:** Barcelona City Council, Barcelona Esports Institute, Generalitat de Catalunya (pending).
- **Security and emergency bodies:** Guàrdia Urbana, Mossos d'Esquadra, National Police, Guardia Civil, Firefighters, SEM.
- **Sports and technical organizations:** clubs and federations for athletics, 3x3 basketball, football 7, paddle, and beach volleyball.
- **Sponsors and private companies:** initial agreements on equipment, health, mobility, and applied technology.

Upcoming Goals

- Consolidate sponsorships and institutional support.
- Continue communication campaigns and media presence.
- Finalize logistics for accommodation, transport, and medical services.
- Define the social program and opening and closing ceremonies.
