Flight to Cusco



Arrival in the imperial city of Cusco. Welcome, assistance, and transfer to the hotel. Rest for acclimatization. 2:00 PM. The tour begins at Qoricancha, the legendary Temple of the Sun and the main ceremonial site of the Inca Empire, which, along with the Convent of Santo Domingo, showcases a fascinating combination of Inca and colonial architecture. Next, you will ascend to the heights above the city to the impressive archaeological complex of Sacsayhuaman, one of the greatest works of the Incas, where you will find gigantic walls of perfectly placed megalithic stones and enjoy the best views of the city of Cusco. From there, we will visit Q'enqo, an ancient site of ceremonies and sacrifices, followed by the Inca military outpost of Pucapucara (or Red Stone). You will take a break at a craft center to enjoy our Inca Tea, a pleasant refreshment. Finally, you will visit Tambomac, the Inca Fountain, an ancient site of veneration for water and rain. Return to the hotel.

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DAY 2 (SUNDAY May 3, 2026)



Exploring the Sacred Valley: Ollantaytambo

Breakfast. 8:00 a.m. Tour to the Sacred Valley of the Incas. Visit to the town of Pisac, a picturesque colonial mestizo town. Mass is celebrated in Quechua on Sundays. We will then visit the towns of Ccoya, Lamay, Calca, and Urubamba along the way. Buffet lunch. In the afternoon, a guided tour of the town of Ollantaytambo, home to the Ollantaytambo Archaeological Park, a gigantic agricultural, administrative, social, religious, and military complex from the time of the Inca Empire (Tahuantinsuyo). Return to Cusco via the town of Chinchero, an ancient Inca agricultural center with beautiful Andean scenery. Its colonial church is a highlight.

DAY 3 (MONDAY May 4, 2026)

Machu Picchu



We'll take you to Ollantaytambo to catch a 1 hour and 40 minute train ride to Aguas Calientes. Today you'll visit the extraordinary UNESCO World Heritage Site of Machu Picchu, a 15th-century wonder perched atop a mountain ridge in the Andes, which remained hidden from the Western world for nearly 500 years. Machu Picchu is one of the most famous historical sites in the world, situated in one of the most breathtaking settings in the Andes Mountains. Even if you've seen a million photos, nothing compares to the experience of standing before this remarkable Inca sanctuary. To call it a magical experience is no exaggeration. Machu Picchu is one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. This tour, led by your private guide, will allow you to discover the



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history, organization, and mysteries of this unique Inca complex. You'll explore the area with its incredible ruins and terraces—an impressive example of Inca engineering—along with its photogenic alpacas, all against the imposing backdrop of Huayna Picchu mountain.

After soaking up its incredible energy, you'll descend back to Aguas Calientes for lunch at a local restaurant and a stroll through this picturesque town. Later in the afternoon, you'll take the train back to Ollantaytambo station. Upon arrival, your private driver will meet you at the station. The driver will be holding a sign with your name and will transfer you to your hotel.

DAY 4 (TUESDAY May 5, 2026)



We begin by picking you up from your hotel between 8:30 and 9:00 a.m. An hour from Cusco, Moray is considered an Inca agricultural research center, a unique place where the large ring of circular terraces provided different microclimatic conditions, allowing for the observation and improvement of the various crops grown at different altitudes in the ancient empire. We continue on to the ancient salt mines of Maras, where the saltwater flowing down from the mountain fills thousands of pools and evaporates, producing high-quality culinary salt. Here, you'll enjoy a unique panorama, perfect for taking beautiful photos. We return to your hotel in Cusco around 2:00 p.m.
Overnight in Cusco.
