Caves of Drach

Situated on the east coast of Mallorca, in the town of Porto Cristo, these caves are a major draw for tourists and are definitely some of the most impressive on the island. They stretch out horizontally for about 1,200 meters and go down to a maximum depth of 25 meters beneath the surface. Inside, you'll find a vast underground lake, Lake Martel, which is regarded as one of the largest subterranean lakes globally.
